



NAON Orthopaedic Nursing Review Course Host Information

Program Target Audience: Nurses and other health professionals who are interested in a comprehensive overview of orthopaedic conditions and diseases.

Purpose:

Explore how the orthopaedic nurse applies critical thinking skills to assess, plan, implement and evaluate care for the various health issues of adult spine disorders, degenerative joint disease, inflammatory disease, metabolic bone disease, musculoskeletal tumors, pediatric/neuromuscular/congenital orthopaedics, operative orthopaedics, orthopaedic complications and orthopaedic trauma and sports injuries. It is an excellent review for those planning to take the Orthopaedic Nurses Certification Exam and those wanting to enhance their orthopaedic knowledge base. Contact hours are provided to attendees.

Course Objectives:

1. Employ appropriate management tactics to address various
2. Formulate individualized, holistic care strategies for the orthopaedic patient.
3. Differentiate methods to prevent, lessen or treat complications in the orthopaedic population.
4. Validate techniques for safe mobilization with assistive devices as appropriate for the orthopaedic patient.
5. Evaluate specific education approaches to promote self-care and maximum independent mobility for the orthopaedic patient.

General Information

Contact Hours:

The course is a one day event offering 7.0 contact hours for each participant who attends the entire course. These contact hours are Category A as designated by the Orthopaedic Nurses Certification Board.

The National Association of Orthopaedic Nurses (NAON) is accredited as a provider of continuing nursing education by the American Nurses Credentialing Center Commission on Accreditation (ANCC-COA).

In order for attendees to receive their contact hour certificate they must be present for the full course.

Course Fees:

The NAON fee to host the course is \$3,250 for one speaker or \$4,250 for two speakers. *This fee is for all courses being held on the continental US. There may be additional charges for courses being held outside of the continental US.*

This fee includes:

- Speaker expenses
- Contact hours for each attendee
- Hard copy syllabi for up to 30 attendees
- NAON staff coordination
- Marketing on the NAON Web site and in the NAON News

If you plan on having more than 30 attendees there will be an additional charge of \$100 per 5 syllabi.

A signed contract must be turned into the national office six weeks prior to the date of the course or a fee of \$500 will be added to the cost of the course.

As the host your facility will be responsible for:

- Meeting Room
- AV equipment
- Food and Beverage (if offered)
- Registration processing
- Speaker hotel accommodations (1-2 nights – dependent upon location and flight availability)

How to Book a Program for Your Facility or Chapter:

- Host contacts NAON with date and location of the review course.
- NAON will secure a speaker based on geographical proximity to course and availability.
- NAON will send contract to host.
- Host sends a signed copy of the contract and payment to NAON.
- Host makes arrangements for location of review course, AV equipment, food and beverage, registration, and speaker hotel accommodations
- NAON contacts host to confirm number of syllabi (30 unless additional are requested) one month prior to the review course.
- NAON contacts host to obtain list of attendees in an excel format and then creates certificates two weeks prior to review course.
- NAON mails contact hour certificates and syllabi to the host one week prior to the review course.
