(There will be no extension date; notification of acceptance/decline by October 2023)

Poster Presentation Proposals are due by September 15, 2023

(There will be no extension date; notification of acceptance/decline by late November 2023)

- Completed Bio and EPT forms
- Learner Need or Practice Gap
- Detailed Summary of Content
- Measurable Outcomes/Objectives and content
- Orthopaedic Innovation

- Evidence-based Practices
- Relevance to Orthopaedic Nursing
- Support of Congress Learner Outcomes
- Minimum of 3 references
- Educational level, Track and Topic, Number of Similar Submissions, ONCB Categories
- Confirmation Presentation is Free of Product/Drug Bias

### **Poster Presentation Proposals**

Poster presentation proposals require a title, purpose, one outcome ("The learner will..."), a summary of the content, and completed bio forms.

### **Research Proposals**

All research proposals additionally require background, problem and purpose, methodology, sample, results, limitations, conclusions, and implications.

#### **Important Notes**

- All submissions are for the May 2024 live conference.
- There can be no more than two (2) physical presenters per poster or three (3) physical presenters per podium presentation.
- A proposal can be for either a podium or poster presentation, but not both.
- NAON does not accept any presentation or poster with bias or product promotion.
- Travel and housing arrangements are the responsibility of each presenter.
