

# NAON Content Permissions Policy

NAON is committed to supporting education and professional development in orthopaedic nursing. We welcome requests from non-profit or non-commercial entities for educational and professional purposes.

#### When You Need Permission

Permission must be requested for any re-use or adaptation of copyrighted material, to include tables, boxes, or figures developed for the NAON product. Permission is not needed to paraphrase general information from a publication with a correct source citation, as with any reference material, but use of direct quotations (with appropriate citation) should be limited, and large block quotations from NAON products should not be used. Additionally, authors and/or presenters may not use verbatim information without permission.

## Exceptions

In some instances, permission from NAON is not required, OR permission must be obtained from other entities. Examples of these instances include, but are not limited to:

- NAON <u>Patient Education Manuals</u> are specifically intended to be printed and distributed as needed to patients undergoing certain procedures.
- Brief citations with proper attribution are permitted and do not require permission.
- Direct requests for Orthopaedic Nursing Journal materials to the Journal editor.
- NAON cannot grant permission to use figures not originally created by NAON (e.g., from open-access sources). Please direct such requests to the content owner.

# How to Request Permission

Complete the required <u>Permissions Request Form</u>. Be sure to specify what content you want to use and your intended purpose. A response to usage requests will be provided within 10 business days. Please note that some instances will require a usage fee.

### **Approved Use Examples**

Requests are evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Approved uses include, but are not limited to:

- Classroom instruction/academic course materials
- New employee orientation programs
- Conference or seminar presentations
- Supporting materials for journal articles or book chapters
- Thesis or dissertation research
- Personal blog or website posts
- Continuing education courses

#### Important Notes

Materials cannot be altered without specific permission, and some materials may not be available for reprint. Each approval covers one-time use only. Granted permission must come directly from NAON, and not the individual authors or presenters of the material.
